


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map




Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 19th to 25th August 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for cumulative forecasted weekly rainfall ranging from 10.6mm to 146.9mm. Most parts of the county are expected to experience between 37.8nn and 146.9mm. Some wards in the Central, Eastern, Southern and Western part of Gem Sub County are likely to experience between 119.6mm and 146.9mm

Period of forecast: Tuesday August 19th to Monday 25th August 2025

Date of issue: Monday 18th August 2025

Summary

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5; morning showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Sunday and Monday. Regions 1 and 2, afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Tuesday, Sunday and Monday. Regions 3, 4 and 5, afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Sunday and Monday. Temperatures of between 26°C and 23°C during the day and between 19°C and 16°C during the night likely. Moderate winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
