**WEEKLY RAINFALL FORECAST**

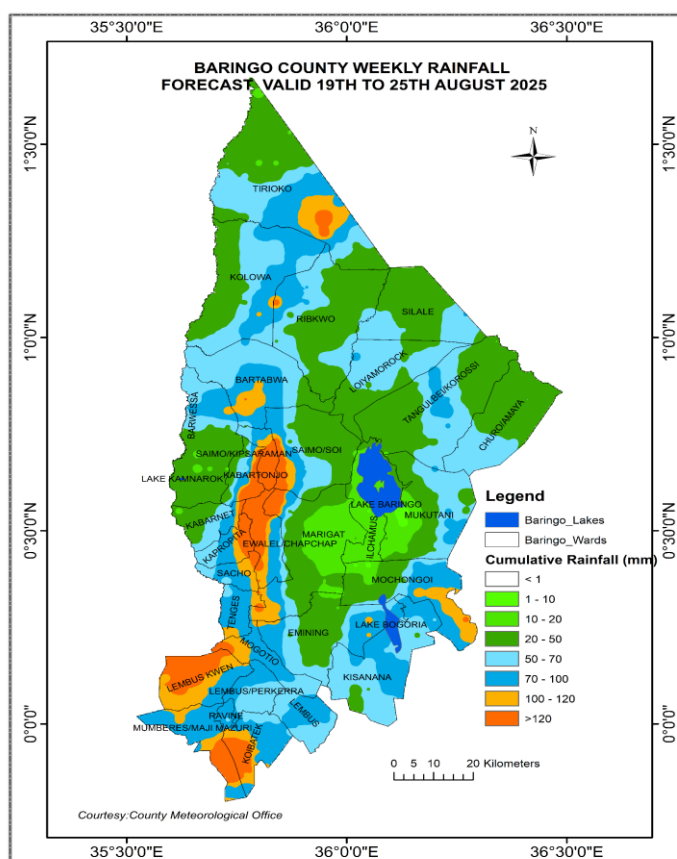
**Period of forecast:** Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> to Monday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2025

**Date of issue:** Monday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2025

**Summary**

- Rainfall is expected to continue with increased spread and intensity countywide as indicated in the spatial map below (fig.1).
- **Flooding** is likely in traditional flood prone areas of the county.
- **Mudslides/landslides** are likely in mudslide/landslide prone areas of the county.
