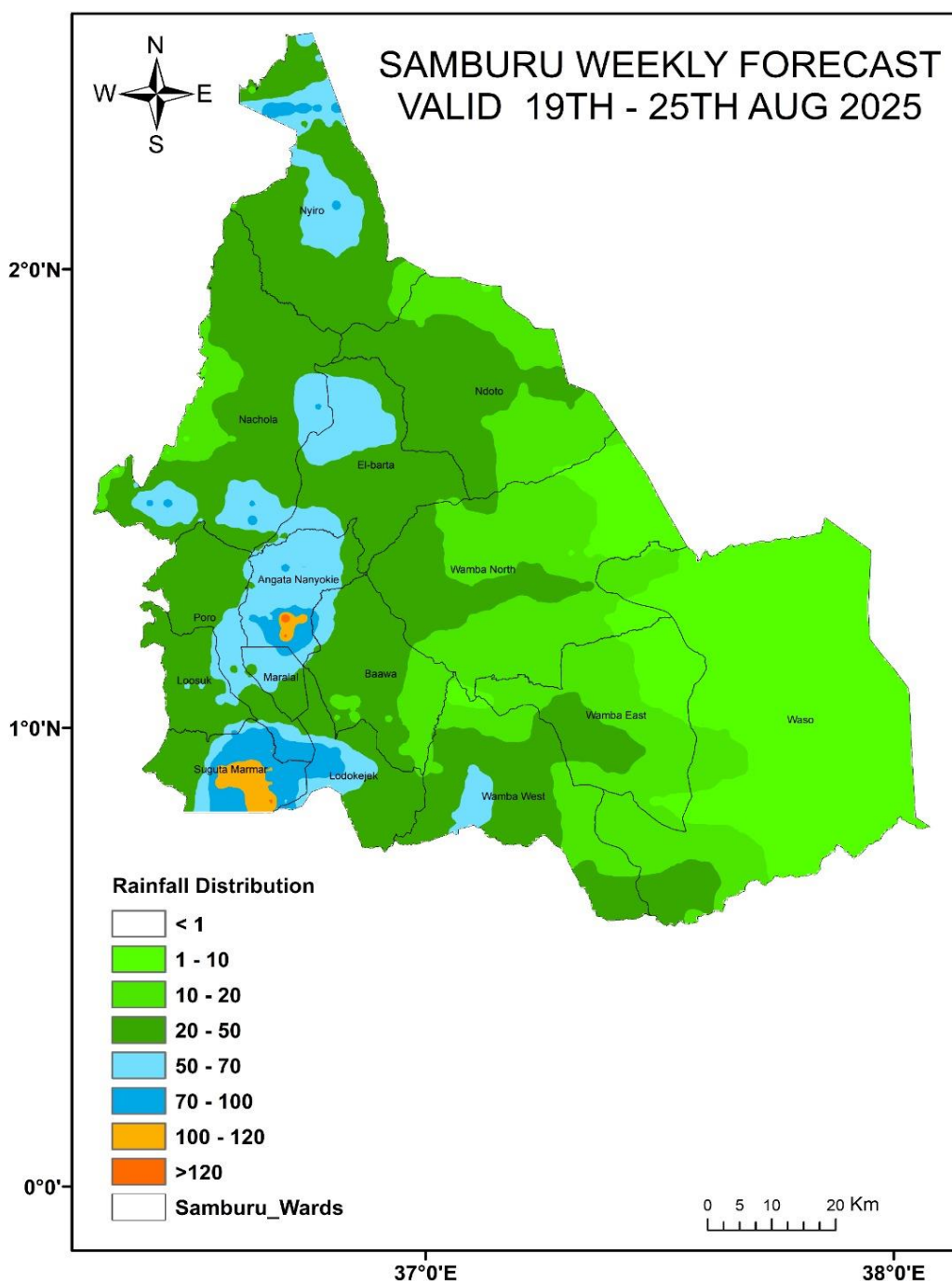

The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 19<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> August,2025

Most of the wards are anticipated to be wet during the course of the forecast period. Morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are expected over several places

### **Commentary of county weather forecaster:**

Samburu County is expected to experience Morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms over several places

- ❖ Morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms over several places
- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 20.0°C and 35.0°C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 10.0°C and 20.0°C

The weather outlook for the week of 26<sup>th</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience wet weather conditions over few areas
