WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST FOR 2ND TO 8TH SEPTEMBER 2025




Figure 1: Cumulative rainfall forecast over Kisumu County




Figure 2: Average maximum (left) and minimum (right) temperature forecasts




Figure 3: Climatic zones in Kisumu County
