Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map




Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 2nd to 8th August 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall ranging from 0.0mm to 4,1mm. Most parts of the county are expected to experience between 0.0nn and 0.8mm. Some areas in Gem, Ugunja and Ugenya are likely to experience rainfall amounts between 0.8 and 4.1mm.

Period of forecast: Tuesday August 26th to Monday 1st September 2025

Summary of The Forecast

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, morning sunny/sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period. Regions 1 and 2, afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over few places likely throughout the forecast period except on Tuesday and Thursday. Temperatures of between 28°C and 26°C during the day and between 20°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
