WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE NEXT SEVEN DAYS VALID 09 - 15 Sept, 2025


Forecast for the next Seven days (09 - 15 Sept, 2025) indicates;

- Slight reduction in wet weather activities is likely over several Places
- However, afternoon showers and thunderstorms are expected to continue mainly in Laikipia West
- The Maximum temperatures expected to range between 18 – 30°C and the (Minimum) temperatures to range 06 - 16°C

Review of weather for the last seven-days (02 - 08 Sept, 2025)

- Stations that recorded rainfall were Kinamba, Ol Pejeta, Mugie, Mutara Orchards, Nanyuki, etc
- Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts decreased
- Both the day time (Max) temperatures and the Night time (Min) temperatures decreased.

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days 09 - 15 Sept, 2025)



Between 1.0 - 75.0 mm of the cumulated weekly rainfall is predicted as indicated in the adjacent rainfall forecast map

Note; Much of the predicted Rains are likely to be observed mainly in Laikipia West and a few other areas.
