SIAYA COUNTY CLIMATOLOGICAL MAP




Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map




Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 9^{th} to 15^{th} September 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall ranging from 0.0mm to 26.8mm. The remaining Parts of the County are expected to experience between 4.8nn and 26.8mm. Some areas of Ugenya and Ukwala wards are likely to experience cumulative rainfall amounts of between 18.2mm and 26.8mm.

Period of forecast: Tuesday 9th to Monday 15th September 2025

Date of issue: Monday 8th September 2025

Summary of The Forecast

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, morning sunny/sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period except on Monday when showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely. Regions 1 and 2, afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over few places likely throughout the forecast period except on Thursday. Regions 3, 4 and 5, afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Temperatures of between 28°C and 26°C during the day and between 19°C and 17°C during the night likely. Moderate winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
