# WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST FOR 9<sup>TH</sup> TO 15<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025




Figure 1: Cumulative rainfall forecast over Kisumu County

# **Summary**




Figure 2: Average maximum (left) and minimum (right) temperature forecasts




Figure 3: Climatic zones in Kisumu County
