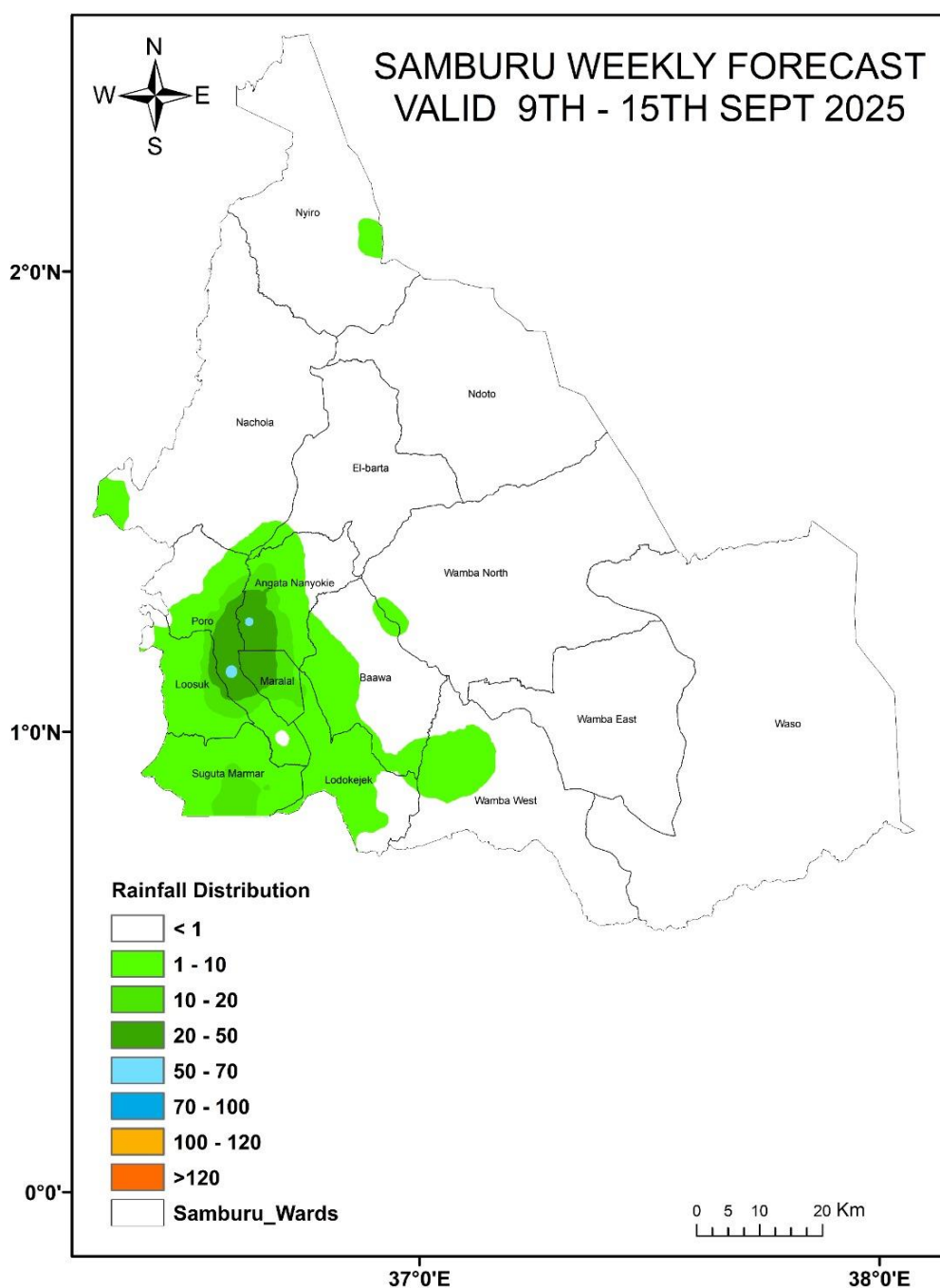


Figure 1: Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast

The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 9th September to 15th September, 2025

Most of the wards are anticipated to be dry during the course of the forecast period

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period

- ❖ sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period
- ❖ The following wards will receive morning rains and night showers
Maralal, Sunguta Marmar, Loosuk and parts of Angata
Nanyokie, Lodokejek and Baawa
- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25.0°C and 35.0°C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 10.0°C and 25.0°C

The weather outlook for the week of 16th to 22nd September, 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience dry weather conditions over several areas
