

## **GENERAL OUTLOOK**

## Morning sea state:

Light to moderately strong S to SSE winds (09-20 knots) with slight to choppy seas. ESE waves of 6-7ft (1.8-2.1m) with small to moderate period waves of (7-10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### Afternoon sea state:

Light to moderately strong S to SSE winds
(11-21 knots) with slight to choppy seas. ESE
waves of 6-7feet (1.8-2.1m) with small to
moderate period waves of (10sec) are
expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and
Lamu.

# Visibility:

 Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong SSE winds with choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.14AM and sunset; 6:19PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 6:00AM; 3.54m, 6:16PM; 3.02m
- Low Tide: 12:14PM; 0.01m

#### iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: SSE 9 to 19 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE7 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 11 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:10AM and Sunset; 6:16PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 6:00AM; 3.41m, 6:17PM; 2.88m
- Low Tide: 12:16PM; 0.02m

# **Advisory**

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.8-2.1m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious in Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (09-21knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious in Kilifi.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7-17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
