

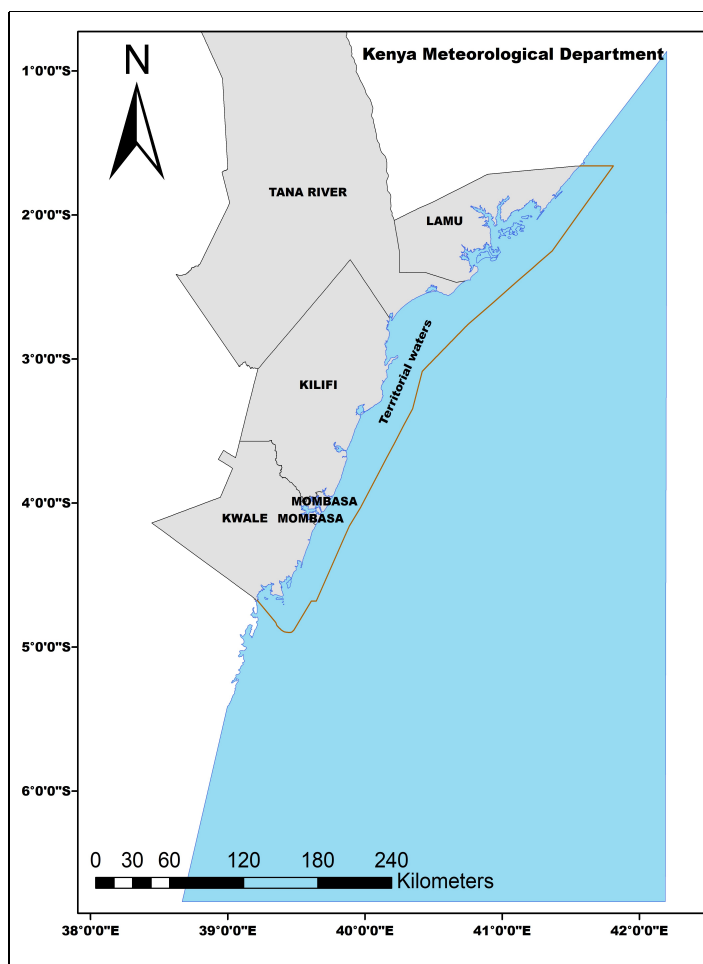

**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light to breezy S to SSE winds (07-17 knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 5-6ft (1.5-1.8m) with small to moderate period waves of (9sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Light to breezy SE to SSE winds (08-19 knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 5-6feet (1.5-1.8m) with small to moderate period waves of (10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## **COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST**

### **i. KWALE**

- Morning Winds: SSE 8 to 11 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SE 8 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SE winds with a slight chop. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; **6:17AM** and sunset; **6:21PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **5:31AM; 3.89m, 5:46PM; 3.62m**
- Low Tide: **11:42AM; 0.05m, 11:51PM; 0.06m**

### **ii. MOMBASA**

- Morning Winds: S 12 to 15 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 6 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 11 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 6 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; **6:16AM** and sunset; **6:20PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **5:38AM; 3.78m, 5:55PM; 3.49m**
- Low Tide: **11:45AM; -0.01m, 11:52PM; 0.03m**

### **iii. KILIFI**

- Morning Winds: SSE 14 to 17 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 6 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 14 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 6 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; **6:15AM** and sunset; **6:19PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **5:26AM; 3.55m, 5:41PM; 3.24m**
- Low Tide: **11:37AM; -0.08m, 11:43PM; -0.06m**

### **iv. LAMU**

- Morning Winds: SSE 7 to 17 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 6 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 10 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 6 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; **6:10AM** and Sunset; **6:16PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **5:27AM; 3.41m, 5:42PM; 3.09m**
- Low Tide: **11:39AM; -0.07m, 11:44PM; -0.06m**

### Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.5-1.8m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (07-19 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.

0.6 – 1.0 m ( $\approx$ 1.8 – 3.0 ft)	Slight	Conditions suitable for Marine activities
1.0 – 1.9 m ( $\approx$ 3.0 – 5.7 ft)	Slight - Moderate	
2.0 – 2.9 m ( $\approx$ 6.0 – 8.7 ft)	Moderate-Rough	Caution on operating marine activities
3.0 – 4.0 m ( $\approx$ 9.0 – 12.0 ft)	Rough	Warning in place!!!!
4.1 – 5.5 m ( $\approx$ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – $\geq$ 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
