HIGHLIGHTS

Forecast for 16th to 22nd September 2025

 Rainfall is expected over some parts of the county. Parts of Suna East and Suna West Sub-Counties are expected to receive the highest rainfall amount.

Weather Review 8th to 14th September 2025

- Rainfall was recorded over some parts of the county during the review period.
- Kuna-Ng'ope Kamilewa Rainfall station recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall total of 92.5mm




Figure 2: 7day cumulative rainfall forecast valid 16-22 September 2025




Figure 3: Maximum Temperature forecast 16-22 September 2025




Figure 4: Minimum Temperature Forecast 16-22 September 2025

The day-time and night time temperatures during the period are as shown in Figure 3 and 4.



Weather Review for 8th to 14th September 2025



- Rainfall was recorded over some parts of the county.
- Kuna-Ng'ope kamilewa Rainfall station recorded the highest rainfall amount of 92.5mm while Koromangucha (90.6mm) recorded the highest rainfall within 24-hour period of 55.2mm on 11th September 2025. Other stations that recorded significant rainfall are Sony Sugar (73.4mm); Ulanda AWS (43.1mm), Miyare (31.3mm); Lela AWS (29.5mm); Nyaroya (26.4mm), while the rest of the stations recorded lass than 20mm.
