General outlook for the week:


REPUBLIC OF KENYA

Most of the county expects to experience cloudy conditions breaking to sunny intervals in the afternoon. However few places expects to receive showers in the afternoon with partly cloudy condition at night.

✓ Winds: to experience moderate South easterly and South South Easterly at about (3 - 8 m/s)

✓ The maximum temperature expected to be high over the period ranges is 22-31°C and the minimum 10 - 22°C.

> Key to rainfall distribution symbols: No rain likely to fall, rain likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain likely to fall in several places (33% -67%), rain likely to fall in most places (more than 67%): Green – No weather-related hazards are expected; Amber Thunderstorms & lightning

Commentary of County Weather forecaster:

- 1. Most of the county expects to experience cloudy conditions breaking to sunny intervals in the afternoon. However few places expects to receive showers in the afternoon with partly cloudy weather condition at night.
- 2. A cool and cold day and night time temperatures are expected to range from $12 33^{\circ}$ C
- 3. Winds: Some areas shall experience moderate South Easterly, South South Easterly breeze at 3 8 m/s.
- 4. Due to the prevailing weather conditions of Cool, Cold and cloudy weather conditions, residents are advised to dress warm and avoid using charcoal burning stoves, 'jiko, in poorly ventilated rooms/ houses; during the cool and cold periods. The burning charcoal with little air produces poisonous carbon monoxide which has no smell but kills
- 5. Expert advice be obtained from the Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary, Public Health and Education offices, among others and take advantage of the prevailing and expected conditions.
