


Figure 1: Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast

The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 16^{th} September to 22^{nd} September, 2025

Most of the wards are anticipated to be dry during the course of the forecast period

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period

- sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period
- The following wards will receive Light rains during the forecast period parts of Loosuk, Angata Nanyokie and Poro
- * Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25.0°C and 35.0° C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 10.0°C and 25.0°C

The weather outlook for the week of 22nd to 29th September, 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience dry weather conditions over several areas
