FORECASTED SEVEN-DAY TOTAL RAINFALL FOR 16TH TO 22ND SEPT 2025

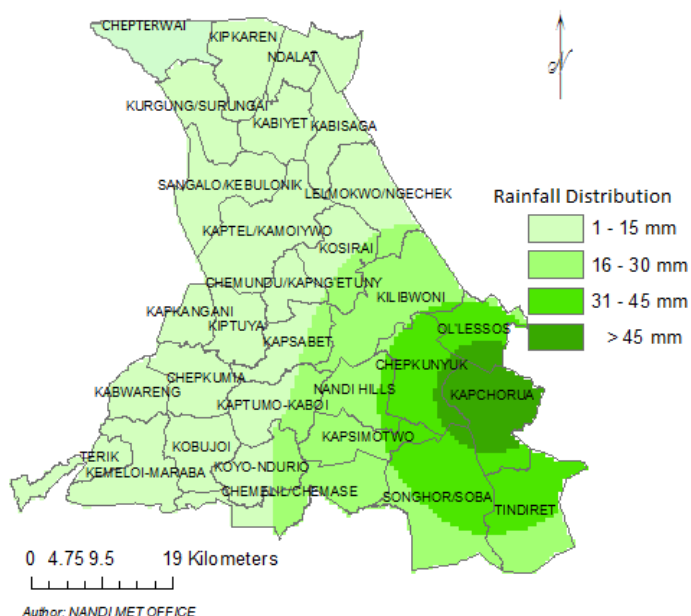


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 16th to 22nd Sept 2025

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Moderate to light rainfall is likely during the forecast period. Moderate rainfall over few places is likely Tuesday, Wednesday and over many places on Saturday. Light rainfall covering few places is likely Thursday, Friday, Sunday and Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 26-32°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°-21°C during the forecast period (page 3)

FORECASTED AVERAGE MAXIMUM TEMP FOR 16T TO 22ND SEPT 2025

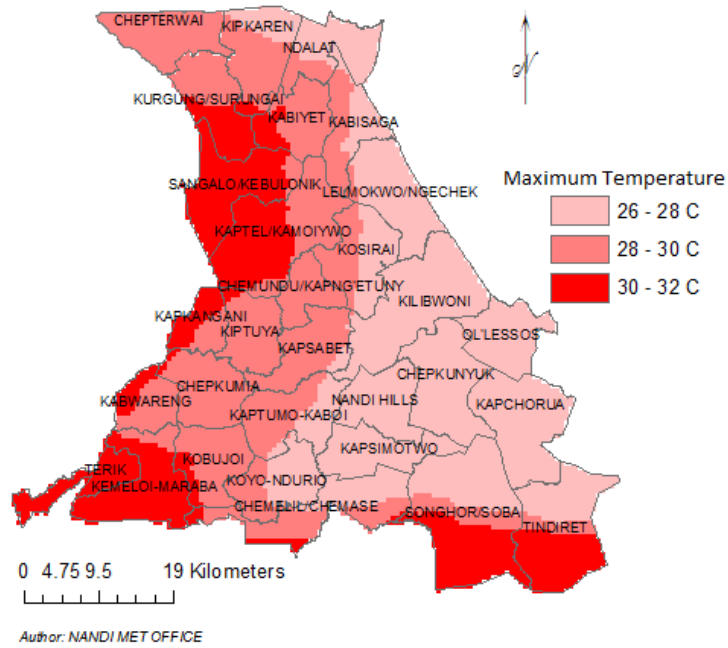


Figure 2: Average Max Temperatures for 16th – 22nd Sep 2025

FORECASTED AVERAGE MINIMUM TEMP FOR 16TH TO 22ND SEPT 2025

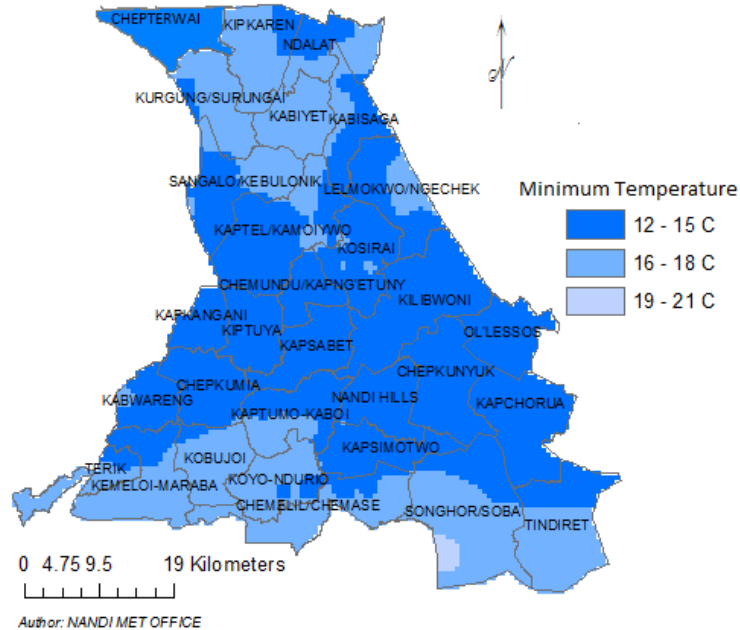


Figure 3: Average Min Temperatures for 16th – 22nd Sep 2025
