Date of issue: Tuesday 23rd September, 2025




Figure 1: Turkana County Weekly Cumulative Rainfall Forecast

The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of rainfall amounts each ward in Turkana County is forecasted to receive from 23rd to 29th September,2025.

Most of the wards are likely to be dry throughout the forecast period. However, morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are expected over few places in Kibish, Nanam and Kaikor wards

Summary of Turkana County weekly weather forecast:

Turkana County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period. However, morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are expected over few places in Kibish, Nanam and Kaikor wards

- > Morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are expected over few places in Kibish, Kaikor and Nanam wards
- > Sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period
- Maximum wind speed expected 21.6km/hr
- Minimum wind speed expected 7.2km/hr
- Maximum temperatures are expected to oscillate between 30.0°C and 35.0°C
- Minimum temperatures are expected to oscillate between 19.0°C and 21.0°C

The weather outlook for the week 30th September to 6th October, 2025 indicates Turkana County is likely to experience dry weather conditions over several areas

EXPECTED IMPACTS

1. **FLOODS:** Riverine and flash floods No risk of riverine and flash floods

2. STRONG WINDS:

Winds of speed 21.6km/hr expected

3. HEAT STRESS:

No risk
