# WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST FOR 23<sup>RD</sup> TO 29<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025




Figure 1: Cumulative rainfall forecast over Homa Bay County




Figure 2: Average maximum (left) and minimum (right) temperature forecast




Figure 3: Climatic zones over Homa Bay County
