

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

Light to breezy S to SSE winds (05-15 knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 5-7ft (1.5-2.1m) with moderate period waves of (10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

• Light to breezy SE to SSE winds (08-16 knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 5-6feet (1.5-1.8m) with small to moderate period waves of (10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

 Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)

iii. KILIFI

- Morning sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 14 to 16 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 6 feet at10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.08AM and sunset; 6:16PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 5:11AM; 3.33m, 5:25PM; 2.98m
- Low Tide: 11:22AM; 0.11m, 11:22PM;0.2m

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 5 to 12 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE6 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 8 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 6 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:05AM and Sunset; 6:12PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 5:12AM; 3.2m, 5:25PM; 2.85m
- Low Tide: 11:24AM; 0.1m, 11:23PM; 0.18m

Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.5-2.1m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (05-16 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7-17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
