FORECASTED SEVEN-DAY TOTAL RAINFALL FOR 7TH TO 13TH OCT 2025




Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 7th to 13th Oct 2025

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Moderate rainfall covering many places is likely on Tuesday. Moderate rainfall covering few areas is likely on Wednesday and Thursday. Light rainfall covering few places is likely on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 25-33°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°-20°C during the forecast period (page 3)

FORECASTED AVERAGE MAXIMUM TEMP FOR 7TH TO 13TH OCT 2025




Figure 2: Average Max Temperatures for 7th to 13th Oct 2025




Figure 3: Average Min Temperatures for 7th to 13th Oct 2025
