



# **GENERAL OUTLOOK**

# Morning sea state:

• Light to gentle S to SSE winds (07-16knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 4-5ft (1.2-1.5m) with small period waves of (8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

# Afternoon sea state:

• Light to gentle SE to SSE winds (07-14knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-4feet (0.9-1.2m) with small period waves of (8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### Visibility:

• Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

- Morning sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 12 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.01AM and sunset; 6:12PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 6:13AM; 3.45m, 6:37PM; 2.62m
- Low Tide: 12:37PM; 0.18m

# iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: SSE 7 to 16 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 7 to 12 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 5.58AM and Sunset; 6:08PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 6:13AM; 3.34m, 6:37PM; 2.49m
- Low Tide: 12:39PM; 0.17m

# **Advisory**

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9-1.5m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (07-16knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.
