Summary

This week's forecast indicates that several places are likely to experience light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience sunny intervals. However few places may experience cloudy conditions.
- In the afternoon few places are likely to experience light rainfall during the first half of the forecast period. Thereafter, several places are likely to receive moderate rainfall.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25 and 28 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 14 and 16 degrees Celsius.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to avoid being struck by lightning.
- Take advantage of the rainfall and plant food crops and trees as the expected rainfall will lead to improved soil moisture.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
