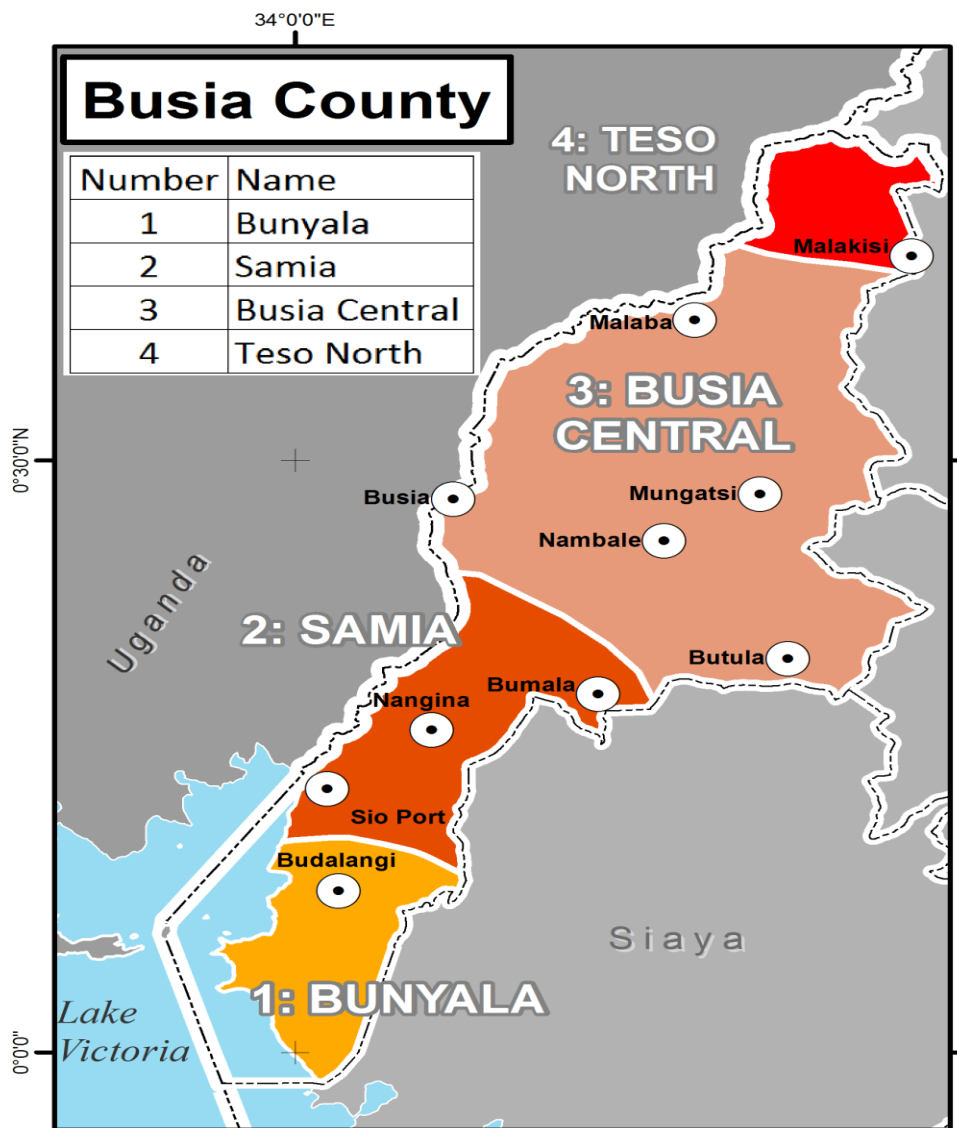

BUSIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST



Period of forecast: Tuesday 14TH October to Monday 20th October 2025

Date of issue: Monday 13th October 2025

Summary

Mornings will experience sunny intervals with occasional rains in few areas. Afternoon showers and lightning strikes, occasionally accompanied by strong winds and hailstones, are expected on Friday to Monday over several places. Nights are likely to be partly cloudy with rains over few areas. Expect afternoon highs of 27°C to 31°C and dawn lows of 18°C to 20°C.

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- This is a great week to **harvest and store rainwater** safely. However, always **monitor river levels** and **avoid crossing flooded areas**.
- When you hear thunder, **act immediately!** Seek shelter inside a solid building, away from windows and doors. **Avoid open fields** and do not stand under trees.
- **Farmers:** This is a dynamic weather period. It is highly recommended to **consult with your local agricultural officer** before planting or spraying crops.
- **Livestock Owners:** **Bring your animals indoors** to protect them from the cold rain, potential hail, and strong winds.
- **Personal Safety:** **Wear rubber-soled shoes** during storms and avoid wet or metal objects.

Note: There may be differences between the forecasted and amount of rainfall received.
