


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map




Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 14th October to 20th October 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall ranging from 0.0mm to 29.2mm. Some parts of Central Alego, Siaya Township, East Alego West Sakwa and South Gem wards are likely to get between 17.5 mm and 29.2mm of rainfall.

Period of forecast: Tuesday 14th October to Monday 20th October 2025

Date of issue: Monday 13th October 2025

Summary of The Forecast

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Morning showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Monday. Regions 1 & 2 afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period except on Tuesday and Wednesday. Regions 3, 4 and 5; afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Friday, Saturday and Monday. Temperatures of between 29°C and 27°C during the day and between 20°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
