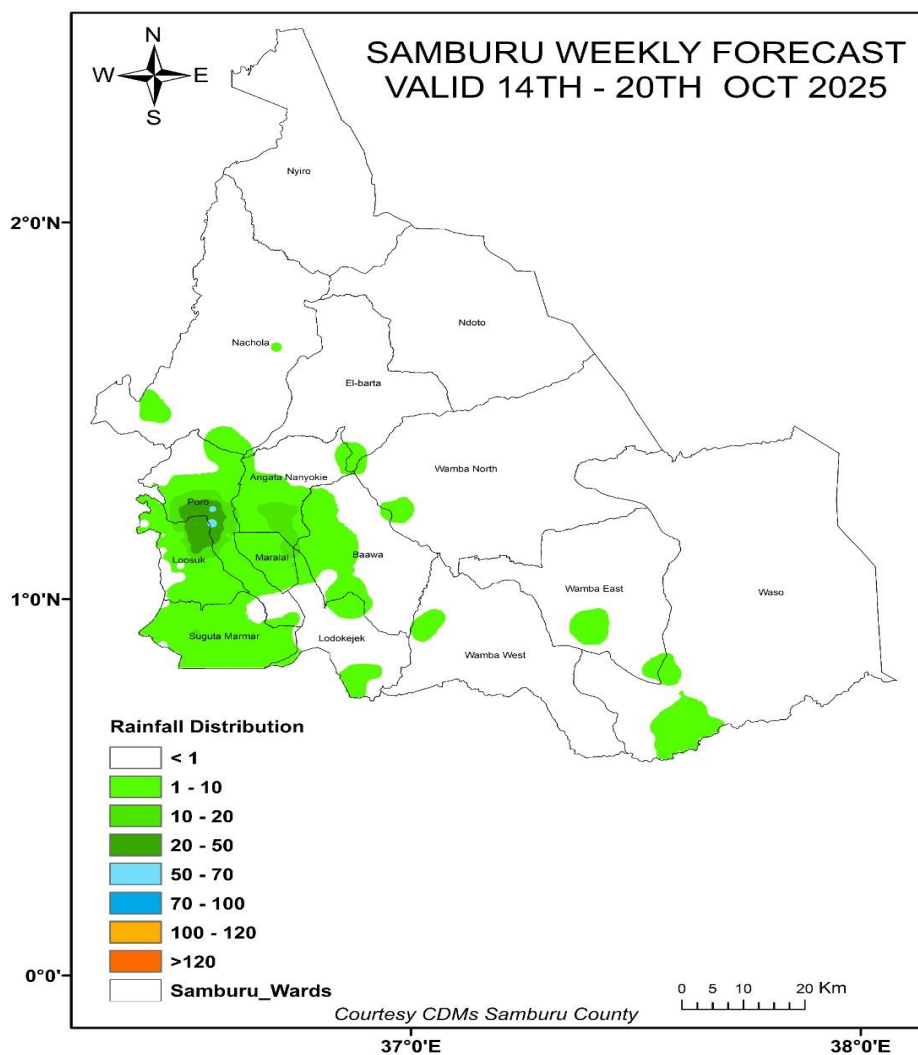


Figure 1: Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period

- ❖ sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period
- ❖ The following wards will receive Light rains in the morning, showers and thunderstorms in the afternoon during the forecast period this will include Maralal, Loosuk, Sunguta Marmar, parts of Angata Nanyokie, Baawa and Poro.
- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 20.0°C and 35.0°C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 10.0°C and 20.0°C.
