## BUNGOMA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Period of forecast: Tuesday 21st to Monday 27th October 2025

### Date of issue: Monday 20th October 2025




Figure 1: Expected Rainfall Distribution valid  $21^{st} - 27^{th}$  October 2025

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> to Monday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2025 is shown in Figure 1.

The amount of rainfall for the week is likely to be more as compared to the previous week.




Figure 2: Expected Average Maximum Temperature valid  $21^{st} - 27^{th}$  October 2025




Figure 3: Expected Average Minimum Temperature valid  $21^{st} - 27^{th}$  October 2025

Figures 2 and 3 below shows the average forecasted maximum and minimum temperatures respectively over Bungoma County for the same period.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  $\bigvee$  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  $\bigvee$  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  $\bigvee$  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%

#### Summary

This week's forecast indicates that several places are likely to experience moderate rainfall during the forecast period.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience sunny intervals. However few places may experience cloudy conditions.
- In the afternoon several places are likely to experience moderate rainfall during the forecast period.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy. However few places may receive light rainfall.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25 and 27 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 14 and 16 degrees Celsius.

#### **Commentary of county weather forecaster:**

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to avoid being struck by lightning.
- Take advantage of the rainfall and plant food crops and trees as the expected rainfall will lead to improved soil moisture.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
