FORECASTED SEVEN-DAY TOTAL RAINFALL FOR 21ST TO 27TH 2025




Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 21st to 27th Oct 2025

Key to rainfall distribution symbols: rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%), rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Morning sessions: Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions**. Moderate rainfall covering many areas is likely during the forecast period.
- **Nights**: Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 25-30°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°-18°C during the forecast period.
