# SIAYA COUNTY CLIMATOLOGICAL MAP




Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map




Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 21<sup>st</sup> October to 27<sup>th</sup> October 2025

## **Summary of The Forecast**

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Morning showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely from Saturday to Monday. Regions 1, 2 and 3. afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period. Regions 4 and 5; afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period except on Tuesday. Temperatures of between 27°C and 25°C during the day and between 20°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
