WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE NEXT SEVEN DAYS VALID 04 - 10 Nov, 2025

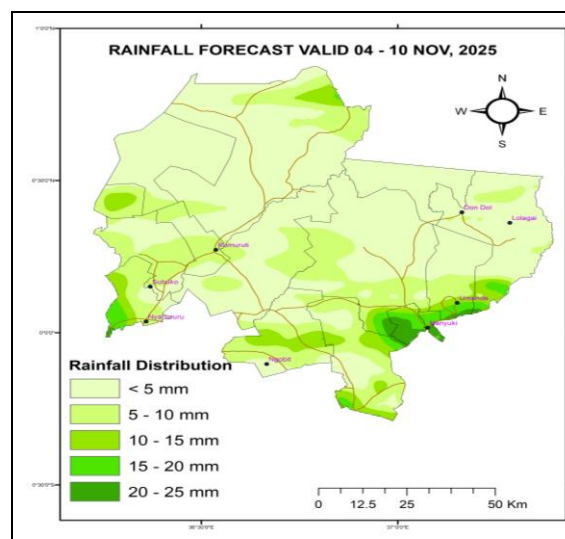
Forecast for the next Seven days (04 – 10 Nov, 2025) indicates;

- Slight reduction in the wet weather activities over most places
- Mainly Sunny conditions in the morning, afternoon showers and thunderstorms over Few Places
- The Maximum temperatures expected to range between 18 – 28°C and the (Minimum) temperatures to range 06 - 16°C

Review of weather for the last seven-days (28 Oct – 03 Nov, 2025)

- Stations that recorded heavy to moderate amounts of rainfall includes Ol Pejeta, Dol Dol Nanyuki, Lol Daiga, Mugie etc
- Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts increased
- Both the day time (Max) temperatures and the Night time (Min) temperatures stabilized

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days 04 - 10 Nov, 2025)



Between 5 – 20mm of the cumulated weekly rainfall is predicted as indicated on the adjacent rainfall forecast map

Much of the predicted rains are likely in the second half of the forecasting period.

- The rainfall belt seems to be shifting from Laikipia West to parts of Laikipia East
- The daily Mean temperatures are likely to reduce in the days with increased clouds and precipitation
