## BUNGOMA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Period of forecast: Tuesday 4th to Monday 10th November 2025

### Date of issue: Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025




Figure 1: Expected Rainfall Distribution valid 4th - 10th November 2025

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> to Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025 is shown in Figure 1.

The amount of rainfall for the week is likely to be less as compared to the previous week.




Figure 2: Expected Average Maximum Temperature valid 4<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> Nov 2025




Figure 3: Expected Average Minimum Temperature valid 4<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> Nov 2025

Figures 2 and 3 below shows the average forecasted maximum and minimum temperatures respectively over Bungoma County for the same period.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  $\bigvee$  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  $\bigvee$  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  $\bigvee$  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%

#### **Summary**

This week's forecast indicates that several places are likely to experience light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience sunny intervals. However few places may experience cloudy conditions.
- In the afternoon several places are likely to experience light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy. However few places may receive light rainfall.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 23 and 29 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 12 and 18 degrees Celsius.

#### Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to avoid being struck by lightning.
- Take advantage of the rainfall and plant food crops and trees as the expected rainfall will lead to improved soil moisture.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
