SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION

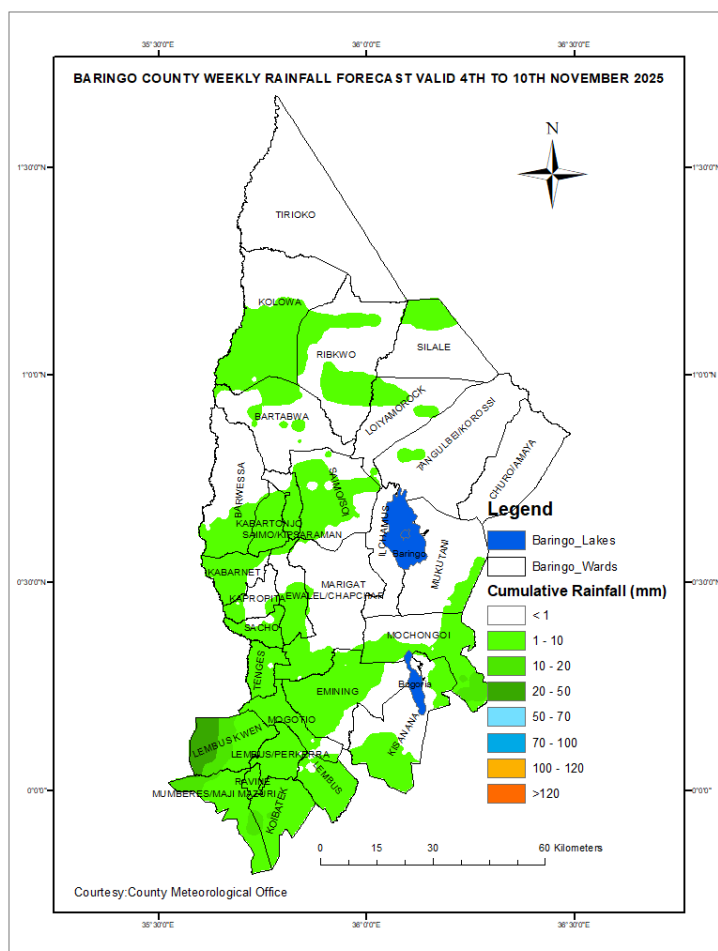


Fig 1. Forecasted cumulative rainfall amounts (mm)
