


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

III. POTENTIAL HAZARDS AND SAFETY ADVISORIES

- 1. Lightning Safety: Residents are advised to avoid sheltering under trees, isolated structures, or near metallic objects during thunderstorms to minimize the risk of lightning strikes.
- 2. Road Safety: Motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians are urged to exercise extreme caution on the roads due to poor visibility and slippery conditions caused by the rainfall, which increases the likelihood of accidents.

IV. SECTOR-SPECIFIC ADVISORIES

1. Agro-Advisory: Farmers are advised to take advantage of the current rainfall for land preparation and planting. For specific guidance on suitable crop varieties, planting

- schedules, and soil management practices, please consult the County Departments of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Co-operative Development.
- 2. Environmental/Public Use: Residents are encouraged to utilize the rainy season for water harvesting and the planting of indigenous and edible fruit tree seedlings as a measure of environmental conservation and food security.
