



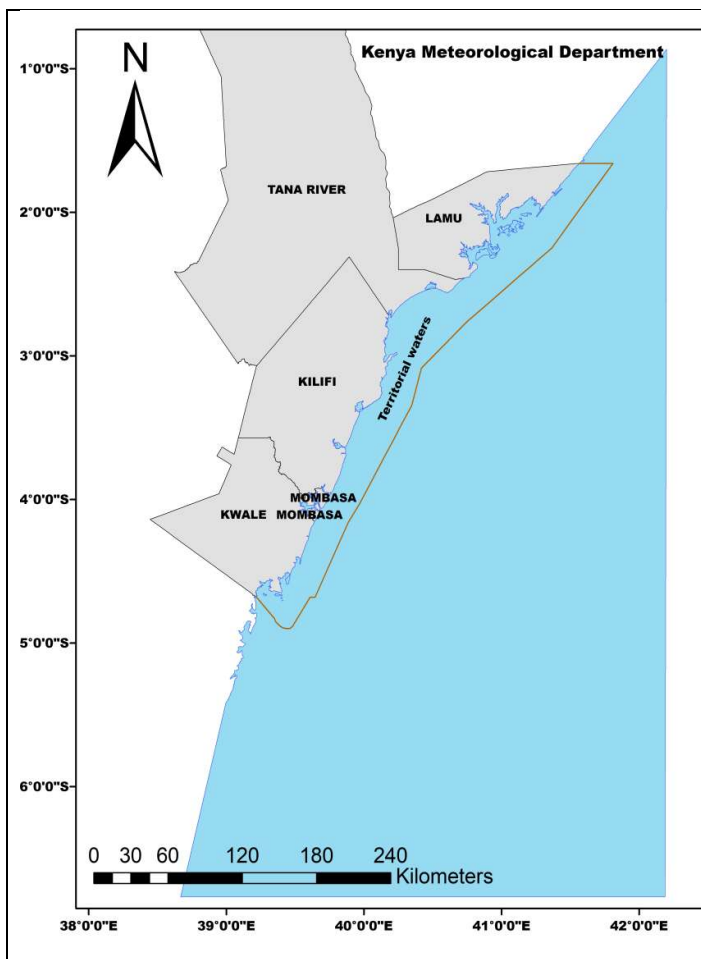

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light and variable winds (03 -09knots) with smooth seas. ESE waves of 2feet (0.6m) with small period waves of 9sec expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Light E to ESE winds (07 -17 knots) with a slight chop. ESE waves of 2 feet (0.6m) with small period waves of 8-9sec expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: W 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 8 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:57AM** and sunset; **06:15PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **6:03AM; 3.76m, 6:33PM; 2.95m**
- Low Tide: **12:30PM; 0.36m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: SW 4 to 5 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 7 to 9 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:56AM** and sunset; **6:13PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **6:12AM; 3.71m, 6:42PM; 2.84m**
- Low Tide: **12:34PM; 0.31m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds S 7 to 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 8 to 9 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:56AM** and sunset; **06:12PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **6:00AM; 3.4m, 6:32PM; 2.57m**
- Low Tide: **12:28PM; 0.18m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: ESE 4 to 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ESE 7 to 12 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 2 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light ESE winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; Sunrise; **05:54AM** and sunset; **06:07PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **6:00AM; 3.3m, 6:32PM; 2.44m**
- Low Tide: **12:31PM; 0.16m**

Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a wave height of 0.6m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (03- 17 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

2.0 – 2.9 m ($\approx$ 6.0 – 8.7 ft)	Moderate-Rough	Caution on operating marine activities
3.0 – 4.0 m ($\approx$ 9.0 – 12.0 ft)	Rough	Warning in place!!!!
4.1 – 5.5 m ($\approx$ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – $\geq$ 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
