November, 2025 to Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2025


#### General outlook for the week:

Rainfall is expected to continue over several places in the first half of the forecast period in the county with reduction of intensity and coverage as compared to the previous week.

The maximum temperature expected to be high over the period ranges is  $25-33^{\circ}$ C and the minimum  $14-22^{\circ}$ C.

- 1. Rainfall is expected to continue over several places in the first half of the forecast period in the county with reduction of intensity and coverage as compared to the previous week.
- 2. A cool and warm day and night time temperatures are expected to range from  $13 34^{\circ}$ C
- 3. Winds: Some areas shall experience moderate Easterly / South Easterly breeze at 3 8 m/s.
- 4. Expert advice may be obtained from the County department of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary, Public Health and Education offices, among others and take advantage of the prevailing and expected conditions.
