Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map




Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 11<sup>TH</sup> November to 17<sup>th</sup> November 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall ranging from 0.0mm to 67.1mm. Most parts of the County are expected to receive between 0.0mm and 13.4mm of rainfall. N. Ugenya, Ukwala, West Ugenya, E. Ugenya, Ugunja wards are likely to experience between 26.8mm and 67.1mm of rainfall.

# **Summary of The Forecast**

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Sunny/Sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period. Regions 3, 4 and 5 Afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period except on Tuesday, Wednesday and Monday. Regions 1 and 2 afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Tuesday. Temperatures of between 29°C and 26°C during the day and between 20°C and 17°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
