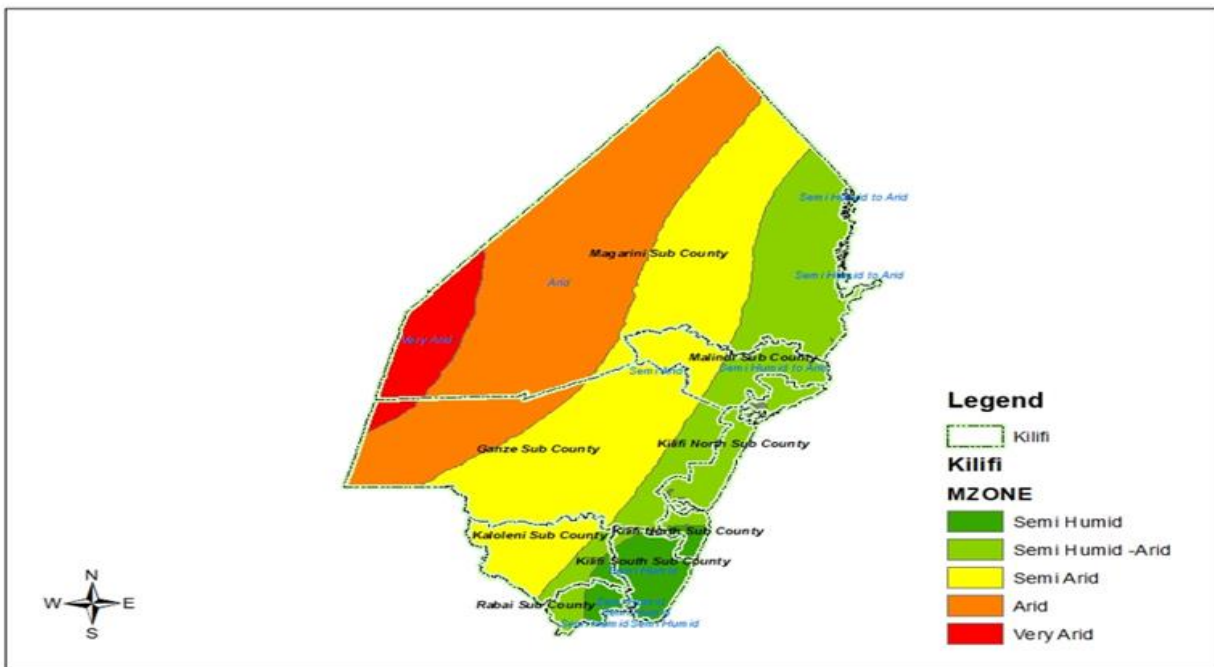

PART I: Weekly weather forecast summary.

- The Minimum/Night temperatures are expected to range from 21-24 °C.

WIND RANGE.	DESCRIPTION.	IMPACT.
< 1 – 7 Knots.	Calm to Light breeze.	1 – 6 Knots; the ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
7 – 21 Knots.	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze.	7 – 17 Knots; Small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
22 - ≥ 34 Knots.	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze.	More than 21 Knots: the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place.
