



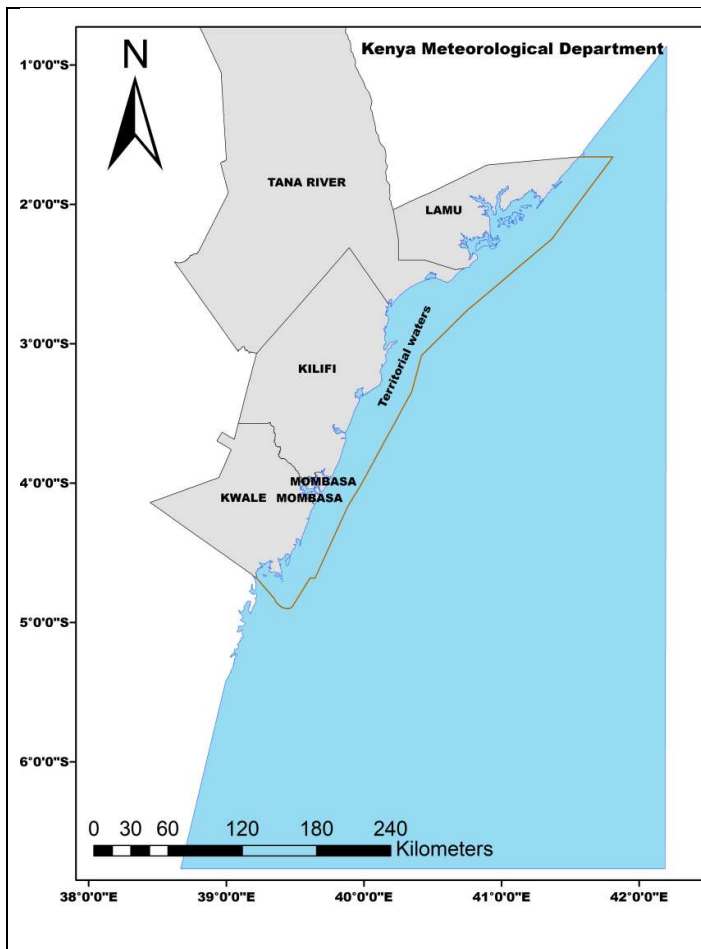

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light and variable NW to NE winds (02-08 knots) with smooth to slight choppy seas. SE to S waves of 2-3feet (0.6-0.9m) with small period waves of (10-12sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Light to moderately strong E to ENE winds (07-19 knots) with a slight to choppy seas. Predominantly S waves of 2 feet (0.6m) with small period waves of (3-12sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NW 4 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 15 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 2 feet at 3 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong ENE winds with choppy seas. Very small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:57AM** and sunset; **06:17PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **2:53AM; 3.38m, 3:15PM; 3.01m**
- Low Tide: **9:15AM; 0.55m, 9:09PM; 0.69m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NNE 4 to 5 knots.
- Morning Waves: SSE 2 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 11 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SSE 2 feet at 12 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:57AM** and sunset; **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **3:02AM; 3.26m, 3:23PM; 2.82m**
- Low Tide: **9:20AM; 0.56m, 9:09PM; 0.64m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds NE 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: S 2 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NE winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 11 to 13 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: S 2 feet at 12 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:56AM** and sunset; **06:14PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **2:50AM; 3.02m, 3:14PM; 2.58m**
- Low Tide: **9:11AM; 0.41m, 9:01PM; 0.55m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: NE 2 to 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: SSE 3 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 7 to 10 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SSE 2 feet at 12seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise; Sunrise; **05:54AM** and sunset; **06:08PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **2:50AM; 2.91m, 3:15PM; 2.45m**
- Low Tide: **9:14AM; 0.38m , 9:02PM; 0.53m**

Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a wave height of 0.6-0.9m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (02- 19 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious in the afternoon while venturing into deep sea in Kwale areas.

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – $\geq$ 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
