


Figure 1: Expected Rainfall Distribution valid 18th - 24th November 2025

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 18th to Monday 24th November 2025 is shown in Figure 1.




Figure 2: Expected Average Maximum Temperature valid 18th - 24th Nov 2025




Figure 3: Expected Average Minimum Temperature valid 18th - 24th Nov 2025

Figures 2 and 3 below shows the average forecasted maximum and minimum temperatures respectively over Bungoma County for the same period.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols: Prain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), and rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%), and rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Key to hazard colours:

Green	No severe weather is expected.
Amber	Severe weather conditions are likely to occur that may pose a threat to life and damage property. Be prepared.
Red	Dangerous and potentially life threating weather conditions are expected. Take appropriate action immediately to ensure your safety and the safety of your family and neighbours.

Explanation of terminologies

Terminology	Meaning
Light rainfall	< 5 mm
Moderate rainfall	5 – 20 mm

Heavy rainfall	20 -50 mm
Very heavy rainfall	>50 mm
Few places	Below 33% coverage
Several places	Between 33% and 67% coverage
Most places	Between 67% and 100% coverage

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that few places are likely to experience light rainfall during the forecast period.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience sunny intervals. However few places may experience cloudy conditions.
- In the afternoon few places are likely to experience light rainfall during the forecast period. However, few places may receive moderate rainfall.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25 and 33 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 15 and 19 degrees Celsius.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
