
#### General outlook for the week:

Rainfall is expected to continue over few places in the county especially in the South Sb county with reduction of intensity and coverage as compared to the previous week.

#### Temperature:

The maximum temperature expected to be high over the period ranges is  $25-34^{\circ}$ C and the minimum  $14-22^{\circ}$ C.

## **Commentary of County Weather forecaster:**

- 1. Rainfall is expected to continue over few places especially in the South sub county during the forecast period in the county with reduction of intensity and coverage as compared to the previous week.
- 2. A cool and warm day and night time temperatures are expected to range from  $13 34^{\circ}$ C
- 3. Winds: Some areas shall experience moderate to strong East North- Easterly breeze at 3 12 m/s. **Keekonyokie ward** and other areas in the South to experience strong breeze in the second half of the forecast period
- 4. Expert advice may be obtained from the County department of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary, Public Health and Education offices, among others and take advantage of the prevailing and expected conditions.
