Temperature range likely to be 12°C-29°C

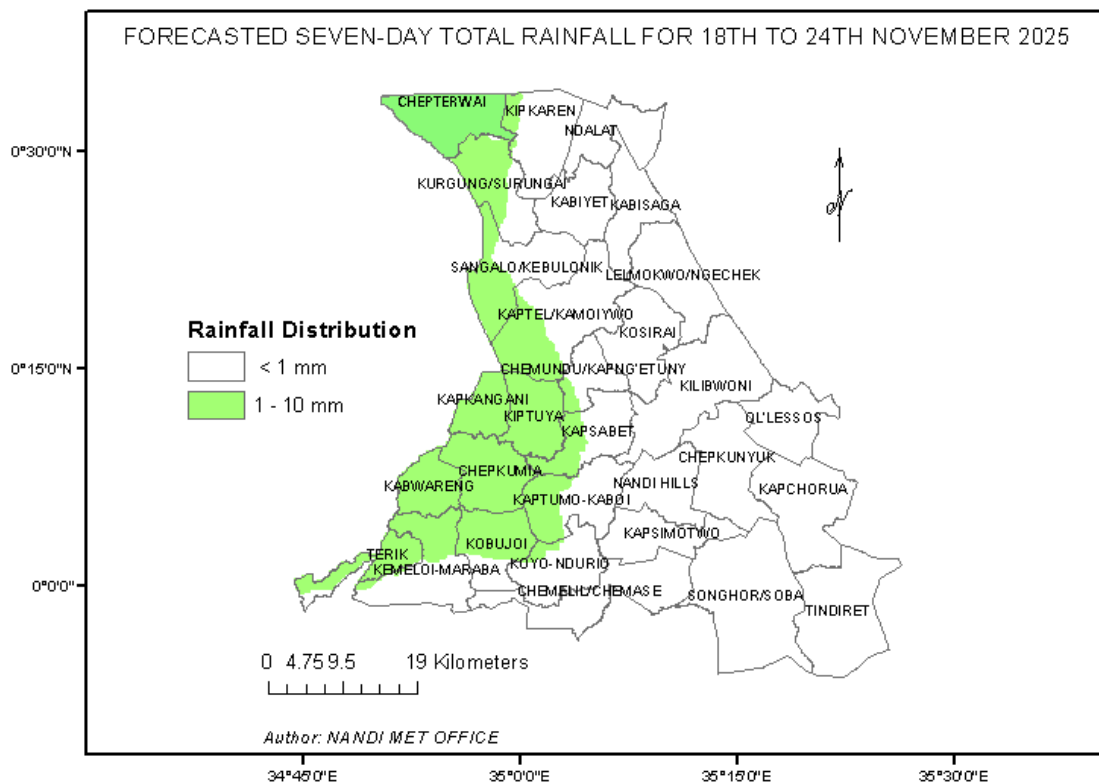































Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> Nov 2025

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

### Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Moderate rainfall covering few places is likely on Tuesday. Light rainfall covering few places is likely on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.

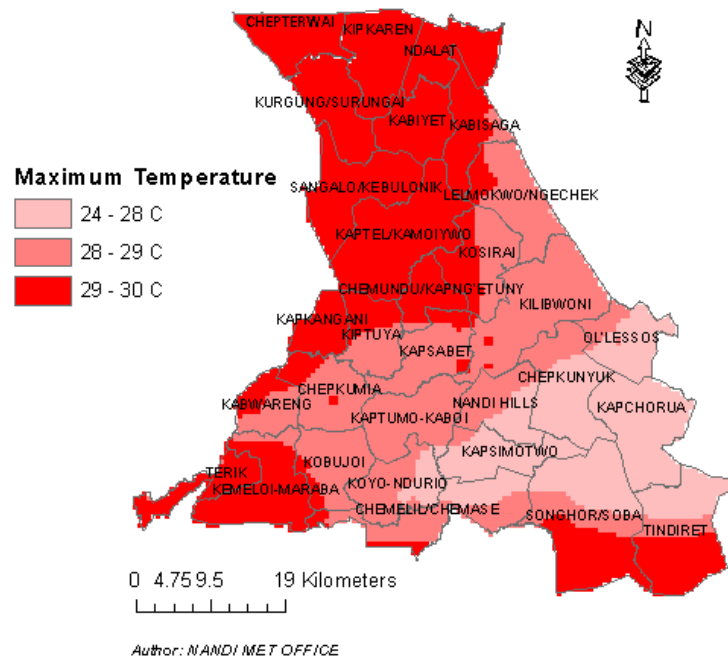


Figure 2: Average Max Temperatures for 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> Nov 2025

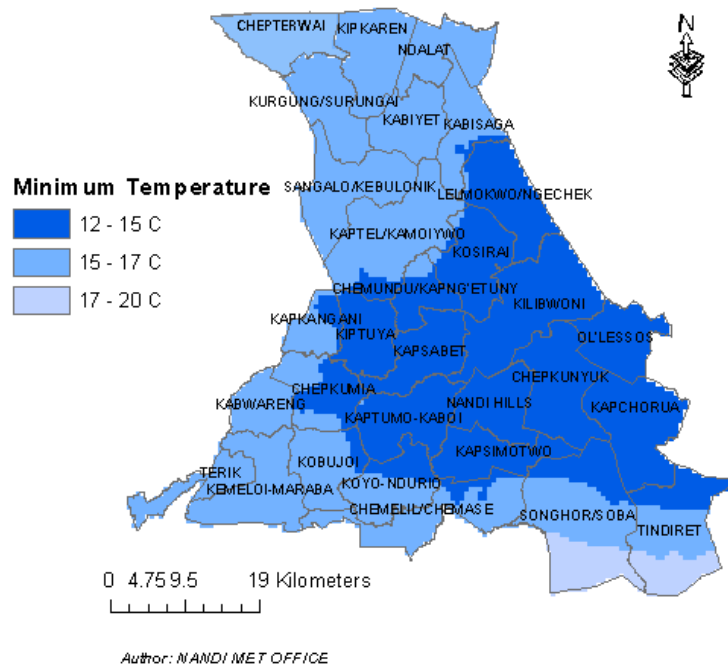


Figure 3: Average Min Temperatures for 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> Nov 2025

- Maximum temperature ranges likely to be 24-30°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°-20°C during the forecast period (Fig 2 & 3 page 3)

FORECASTED AVERAGE MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FOR 18TH TO 24TH NOVEMBER 2025

FORECASTED AVERAGE MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FOR 18TH TO 24TH NOVEMBER 2025
