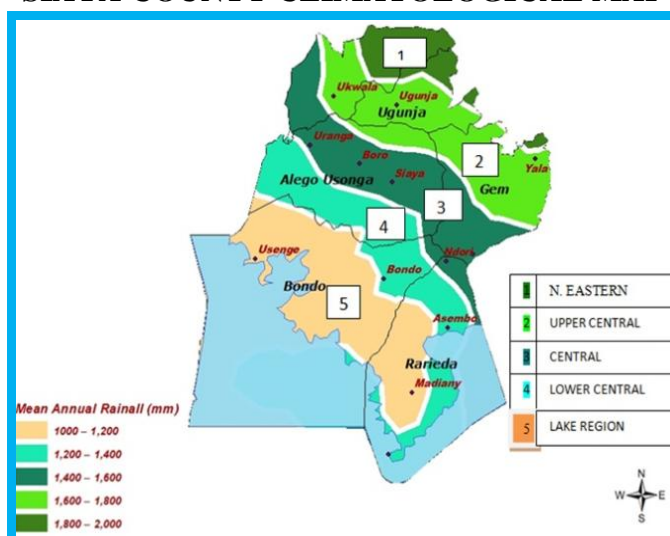


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map

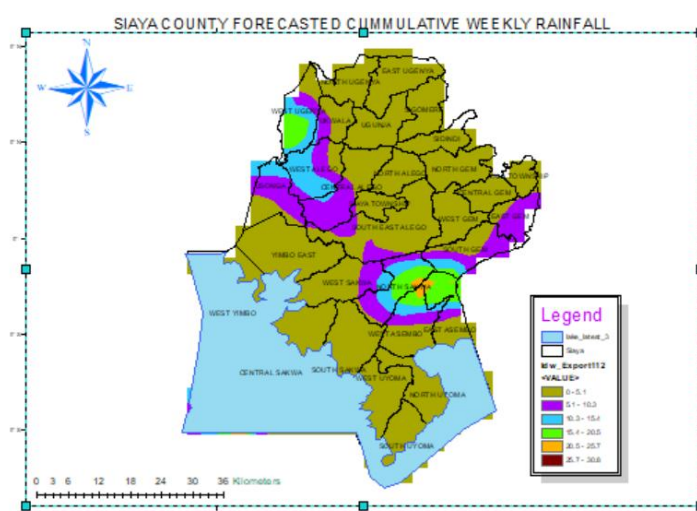


Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 18<sup>TH</sup> November to 24<sup>th</sup> November 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall ranging from 0.0mm to 30.8mm. Most parts of the County are expected to receive between 0.0mm and 5.1.1mm of rainfall. Few places in the N. Western and Eastern parts of the county are likely to experience between 5.1mm and 25.7mm of rainfall cumulatively.

### Summary of The Forecast

*Region 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 Sunny/Sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period. Region 3; afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over few places likely on Thursday and Friday. Regions 1, 2, 4 and 5 afternoon/night Cloudy/clear sky conditions likely throughout the forecast period. Temperatures of between 29°C and 27°C during the day and between 20°C and 19°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period*
