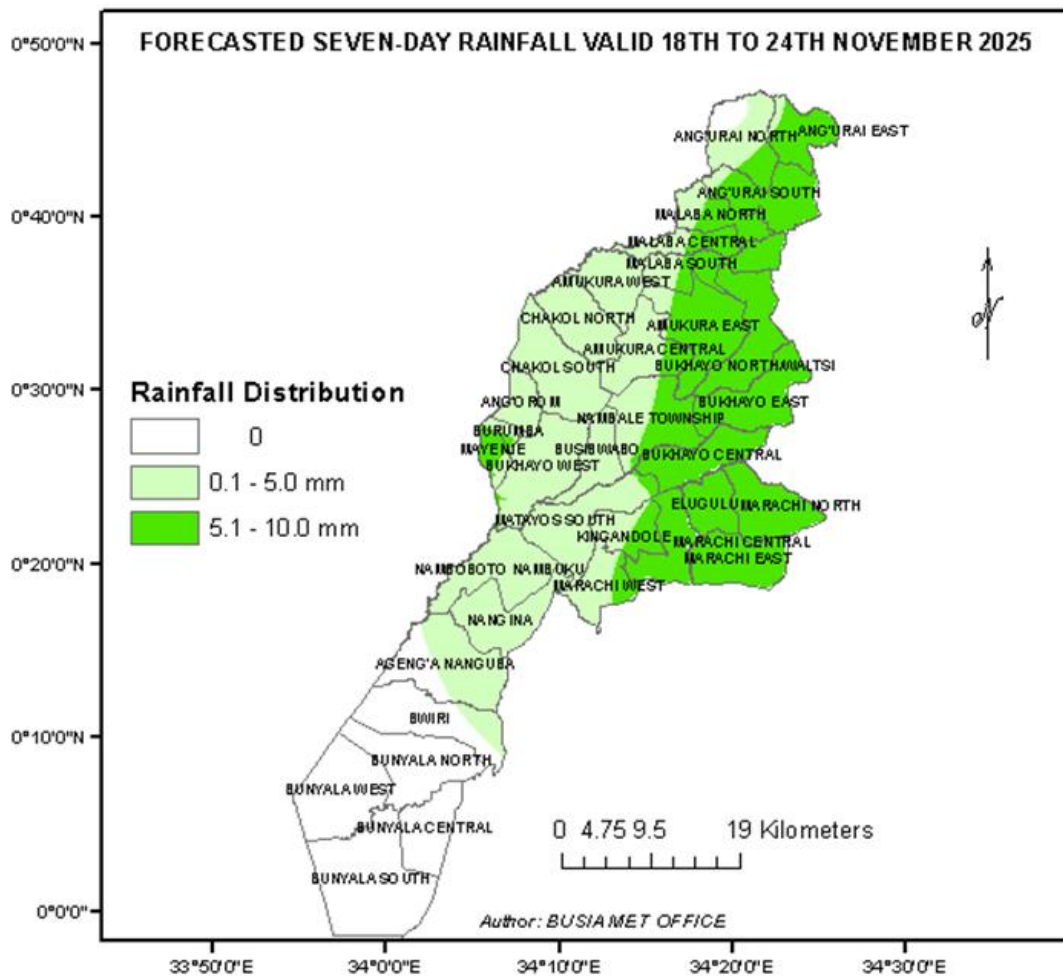

BUSIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST



Period of forecast: Tuesday 18th November to Monday 24th November 2025

Date of issue: Monday 17th November 2025

Summary

Sunny intervals are expected during the day, with partly cloudy conditions at night. However, there is a chance of morning rains on Saturday as well as light afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms that may occur over few places.

The Eastern parts of the northern half of Busia County are likely to receive more rainfall, with some places getting between 5.1mm to 10mm during the 7-day period. Overall there is likely to be less rainfall in Busia County than last week.

Temperatures will be slightly higher than last week. Expect afternoon highs of 27°C to 31°C and dawn lows of 17°C to 20°C.

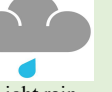

Key to rainfall space distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in **few places** (less than 33%, 0% inclusive),  rain is likely to fall in **many/several places** (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in **most places** (more than 67%).

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- Eastern parts of Butula, Nambale, Teso South and Teso North Sub Counties are likely to have more rainfall than the rest of the County.
- A reduction in rainfall is expected during the week.
- Harvest rainwater and store it safely for future use.
- If you hear thunder or see lightning, find shelter inside a building. Stay away from windows and doors.
- Protect your animals from cold rain and the risk of lightning strikes, strong wind or hail by bringing them indoors when it rains.
- Mulch your farms to retain moisture among growing plants.

Note: There may be differences between the forecasted rainfall and the actual amount of rainfall received.
