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MOMBASA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 18 – 24 NOV 2025

PART-I: Mombasa County Weekly Weather Outlook

- 1 We are expecting a mixed weather conditions during the forecast week. A few places will experience slight showers in the morning and afternoon during the forecast week.
- 2 The expected range of daytime MAXIMUM temperature is 31 33 °C; the average MINIMUM temperature will be around 25 °C.
- 3 Moderate winds are expected throughout the forecast week. Wind strength will vary between 7-8 m/s (14–16 Kt) throughout the forecast period.
- 4 SLIGHT sea conditions will prevail throughout the forecast week. Wave heights of between 0.6 m to 1.5 m (1.8 to 4.5 ft). the conditions are favourable for Marine activities
- 5 CAUTION IS HOWEVER ADVISED WHILE CONDUCTING MARINE ACTIVITIES IN DEEP SEAS DURING THE WEEK





WEEKLY RAINFAL DISTRIBUTION VALID 18 – 24 NOVEMBER 2025




Rainfall totals 10 – 50 mm

10 DAYS FORECASTS FOR WINDS, PRECIPITATIONS AND TEMPERATURE MOMBASA



TEN DAYS SIGNIFICANT WAVE HEIGHTS, WINDS, OVER SOUTH WEST INDIAN OCEAN



The distribution of wind directions are predominantly East throughout the 10 days forecast period, the wind speeds vary between 3m/s and 7 m/s, the significant wave heights vary between 0.6 m and 1.0 m. The wave directions are Easterly (E) and the wave periods between 5 and 8 seconds
