



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

Light N to NE winds (03-07knots) with smooth to slight choppy seas. ESE to ENE waves of 2-3feet (0.6-0.9m) with small period waves of (5-9sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

• Breezy to moderately strong NE to ENE winds (11 -25 knots) with moderate to choppy seas. ENE waves of 3-4 feet (0.6-0.9m) with small period waves of (4-5sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

• Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: N 6 to 10 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 2 feet at 5 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light N winds with a slight chop. Very small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: NE 18 to 25 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong NE winds with choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; 05:57AM and sunset; 06:18PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 3:52AM; 3.6m, 4:16PM; 3.04m
- Low Tide: 10:15AM; 0.39m, 10:05PM; 0.61m

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: N 6 to 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light N winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 16 to 22 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 3 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong ENE winds with choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; 05:57AM and sunset; 6:16PM
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: 3:59AM; 3.46m, 4:22PM; 2.9m
- Low Tide: 10:18AM; 0.39m, 10:07PM; 0.57m

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds NE 8 to 10 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NE winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 17 to 22 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong ENE winds with choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; 05:57AM and sunset; 06:15PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 3:48AM; 3.18m, 4:14PM; 2.64m
- Low Tide: 10:11AM; 0.21m, 10:00PM; 0.45m

iv. <u>LAMU</u>

- Morning Winds: NE 4 to 10 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 11 to 22 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 3 feet at 4 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; Sunrise; 05:55AM and sunset; 06:09PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 3:48AM; 3.07m, 4:15PM; 2.5m
- Low Tide: 10:13AM; 0.19m, 10:01PM; 0.43m

Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a wave height of 0.6-1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Gentle to strong breeze of (11- 25 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu in the
 afternoon. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea in
 Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
