



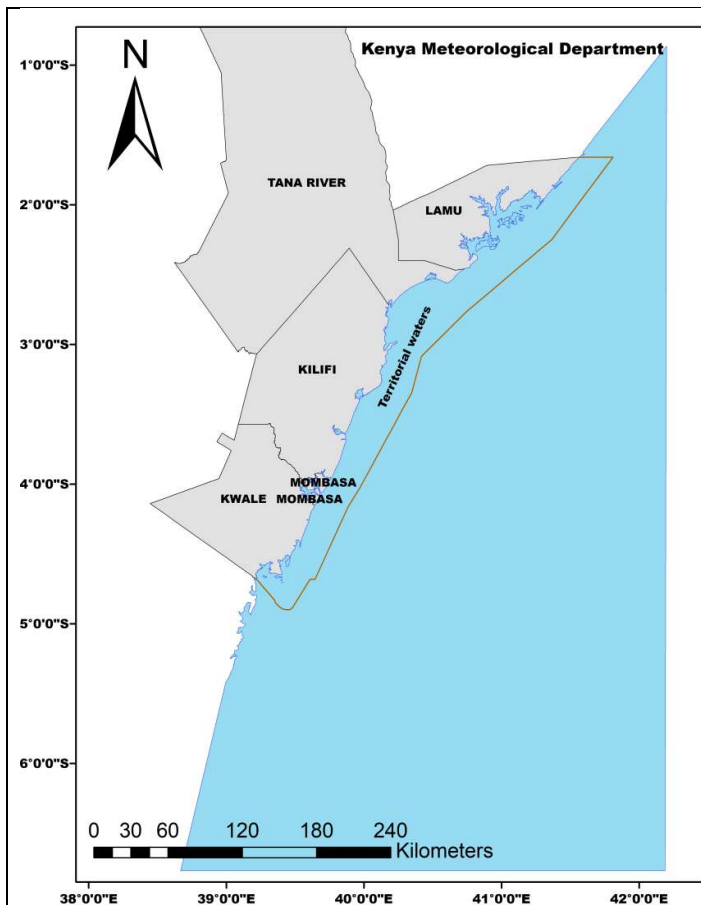

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light to breezy NNW to NE winds (03-14knots) with smooth to slight choppy seas. ESE to E waves of 3 feet (0.9m) with small period waves of 5-8sec expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Breezy to moderately strong ENE winds (13-24 knots) with moderate to choppy seas. ENE waves of 4 feet (1.2m) with small period waves of 5sec expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NNW 4 to 5 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 16 to 23 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong ENE winds with choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:58AM** and sunset; **06:18PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **4:21AM; 3.63m, 4:45PM; 2.99m**
- Low Tide: **10:45AM; 0.39m, 10:34PM; 0.62m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NNW 4 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 14 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:57AM** and sunset; **6:16PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **4:28AM; 3.48m, 4:51PM; 2.89m**
- Low Tide: **10:47AM; 0.38m, 10:36PM; 0.59m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: NE 11 to 14 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 5 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy NE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 15 to 20 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong ENE winds with choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:57AM** and sunset; **06:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **4:17AM; 3.2m, 4:43PM; 2.61m**
- Low Tide: **10:41AM; 0.2m, 10:30PM; 0.46m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: NE 3 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 13 to 24 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 5 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise; **05:55AM** and sunset; **06:09PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **4:17AM; 3.09m, 4:44PM; 2.48m**
- Low Tide: **10:43AM; 0.18m , 10:30PM; 0.44m**

Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a wave height of 0.6-1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Gentle to strong breeze of (13- 24 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu in the afternoon. Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea in Kwale and Lamu.

4.1 – 5.5 m ($\approx$ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – $\geq$ 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
