

#### **GENERAL OUTLOOK**

## Morning sea state:

Calm to Light breeze E to N winds (01 - 05 knots) with light variable winds and smooth seas. ENE to ESE waves of 1 - 2 feet (0.3m - 0.6m) with period waves of (07 - 10 sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### Afternoon sea state:

Gentle to Fresh breeze ENE to E winds (08 - 19 knots) with slight to strong winds and choppy seas. E to ESE waves of 2 - 3 feet (0.6m - 0.9m) with period waves of (04 - 09 sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## Visibility:

• Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon Winds: E 8 to 15 knots.

• Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.

Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.

• Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
