

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

Light to Fresh breeze N to NNE winds (02-13 knots) with light variable winds and smooth to moderate choppy seas. ENE waves of 3-4 feet (0.9m - 1.2m) with period waves of (06 sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

Gentle to Strong breeze ENE to E winds (11-22 knots) with moderate to strong winds and choppy seas. NE to E waves of 4 feet (1.2m) with period waves of (05 - 08 sec) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

• Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Morning sea state: Light NNE winds with a slight chop. Small very short period waves.

• Afternoon Winds: ENE 15 to 18 knots.

• Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 8 seconds.

Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.

• Sunrise; 06:01AM and sunset; 06:19PM

• Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)

• High Tide: 00:31AM; 2.7m, 12:58PM; 2.3m,

• Low Tide; 06:58AM; 0.8m, 06:53PM; 0.8m,

iv. LAMU

Morning Winds: N 2 knots.

• Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 6 seconds.

Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small very short period waves.

Afternoon Winds: E 11 to 21 knots.
Afternoon Waves: E 4 feet at 5 seconds.

Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.

• Sunrise; Sunrise; 05:58AM and sunset; 06:12PM

• Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)

• High Tide: 00:32AM; 2.6m, 12:58PM; 2.2m,

• Low Tide: 07:01AM; 0.8m, 06:53PM; 0.7m,

Advisory

- Slight to moderate Sea conditions are expected with a wave height of 0.9m 1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to Strong breeze of (02 22 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
