General outlook for the week:


Most places of the county are likely to be sunny and dry weather conditions during the forecast period. However, few places are likely to receive light rains as compared to the previous week.

Commentary of County Weather forecaster:

- 1. Most places of the county are likely experience sunny and dry weather conditions during the forecast period. However, few places are likely to receive light rains as compared to the previous week.
- 2. A cool and warm day and night time temperatures are expected to range from $13-35^{\circ}$ C
- 3. Winds: Some areas shall experience moderate to strong East North- Easterly breeze at 3 12 m/s.
- 4. Expert advice may be obtained from the County department of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary, Public Health and Education offices, among others and take advantage of the prevailing and expected conditions.
