Most parts of the county are likely to remain sunny and dry during the forecast period. However, rainfall is likely over few areas of the county

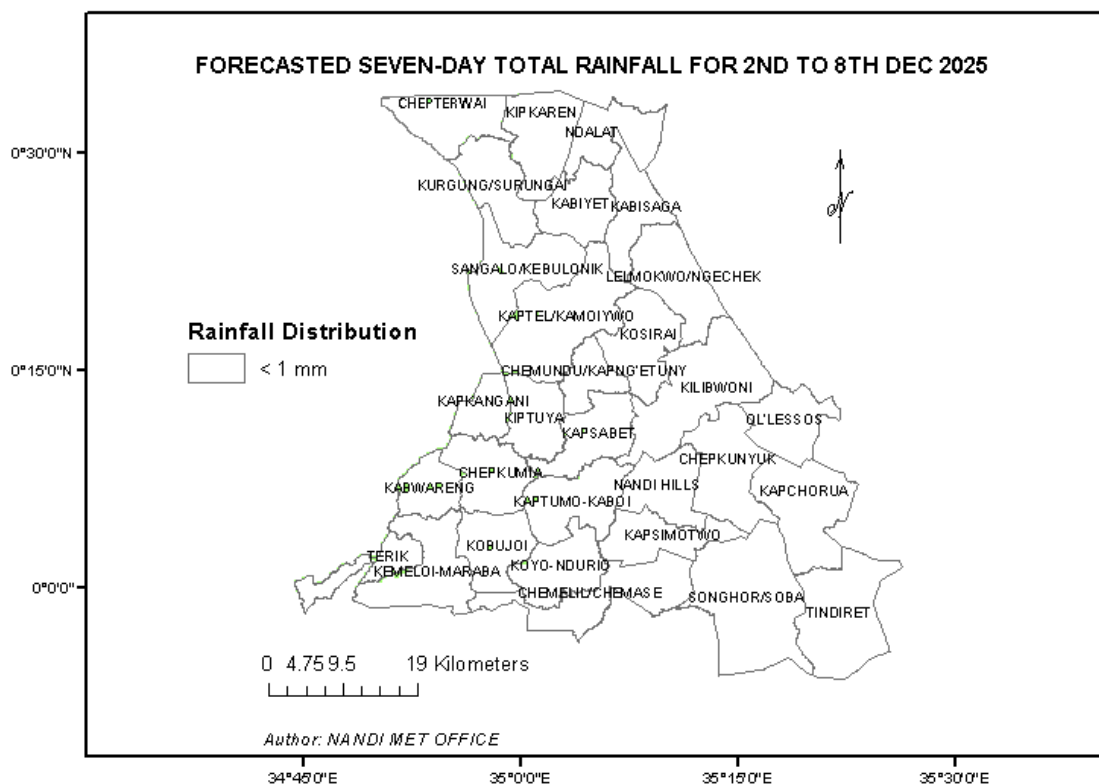




























Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 2nd to 8th Dec 2025

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Mainly sunny intervals to dominate most parts of the county during the forecast period. Few areas are likely to receive light rainfall on Sunday and Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature ranges likely to be 28-29°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12° - 16°C during the forecast period
