

7 Day Cumulative Rainfall Forecast valid 2nd to 8th Dec 2025


- Isiolo County Seven day weather forecast valid from 2nd to 8th Dec 2025 indicates a decrease in rainfall amounts as well as spatial coverage over most parts of the County during the forecast period as shown on the forecast map below.
- Sunny intervals are expected during the day, with partly cloudy conditions at night.
- However, there is a possibility of morning rains and afternoon showers occurring over few places in Wabera Bula Pesa and Burat during the forecast period as is indicated on the forecast map below.

- The state of rainfall distribution is expected to decrease as compared to previous forecast period (25th Nov to 1st Dec 2025)
- Light to Moderate southerly to south-easterly winds with speeds less than 25 knots (12.9 m/s) are expected over several parts of the County

ACCUMULATED AMOUNT OF RAINFALL VALID FROM 1ST TO 8TH DECEMBER 2025




Isiolo Seven Day temperature forecast valid from 2nd to 8th Dec 2025

- Average daytime (maximum) temperatures more than 30 degree Celsius will be experienced in several parts of the County. However, few parts around Kina, Wabere and Oldoniro are expected to be slightly cold in the in the morning hours (below 30 degree Celsius).
- Average night-time (minimum) temperatures will be moderate ranging from 10 to 25 degree Celsius over most parts of the region.

Advisory

- The Ewaso Nyiro river catchment Counties (Meru, Nyandarua and Samburu) is expected to receive reduced rainfall hence reduced downflow during the forecast period which may not significantly affect the current condition of the community as shown on the forecast map below.
- Communities are urged to conserve fodder for their livestock as they prepare for dry spell.
- Community members are encouraged to keep following official weather updates for any changes.
- *This forecast should be used in conjunction with the daily (24-hour) and five-day forecasts issued by Kenya meteorological Department.*
- *Isiolo County locational specific forecasts are available from the County Directors of Meteorological Services, Isiolo Meteorological office .*
