15th December 2025


General outlook for the week:

Rainfall is expected over several places in the second half of the forecast period, whereas in the some areas in the South is likely to receive rainfall during the period.

✓ Winds: to experience moderate to strong EastNorth Easterly at about (3 - 12 m/s)

Temperature:

The maximum temperature expected to be high over the period ranges is 25- 34°C and the minimum 14 - 22°C.

- 1. Rainfall is expected over several places in the second half of the forecast period, whereas in the some areas in the South is likely to receive rainfall during the period.
- 2. A cool and warm day and night time temperatures are expected to range from $13 34^{\circ}$ C
- 3. Winds: Some areas shall experience moderate to strong East North- Easterly breeze at 3 12 m/s.
- 4. Expert advice may be obtained from the County department of Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary, Public Health and Education offices, among others and take advantage of the prevailing and expected conditions.
